## Prince William County

- Economic Development:

# Assistance to Local Businesses - Local

## Prince William County

- Finance: The Procurement Office and the Prince William Chamber recently cosponsored a successful day long session introducing numerous local firms on how to do business with the County.
  - In 2014 the procurement manager spoke to an audience of 30+ local businesses.
  - In March 2015 procurement held an open house.
  - In April 2015 the procurement manager spoke at the Chamber Government Contractors annual event.
- Planning and Economic Development: This joint project showcases certain Potomac Shores locations for redevelopment and investment. If successful, the results could be additional traffic to the area that might stimulate local businesses and an increase in property value for businesses that own and maintain facilities.

## Flory Center

- International Business Development Program (IBDP): IBDP offers a selection of targeted programs to assist both US and international small and medium information technology enterprises develop international business.
- Procurement Technical Assistance Program (PTAP): PTAP is a Defense Logistics Agency and GMU cooperative agreement to provide assistance to increase contracting and sub-contracting activity among small businesses, major prime contractors, and federal, state and local government in this locality.

# Assistance to Local Businesses - State

## Virginia Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity (SBSD)

The mission of the SBSD is to promote access to the Commonwealth of Virginia's contracting opportunities and ensure fairness in the procurement process. The SBSD has three key goals:

- (1) increase the number of certified businesses in the Commonwealth,
- (2) increase the total dollars allocated to Small, Women-owned, and Minority-owned Business (SWaM) vendors as a percentage of all discretionary spend or contract dollars, and,
- (3) offer a business one-stop resource of individuals starting a small business. <http://bos.virginia.gov/>
