2. **Accomplishment (20 points):** Select the **1** accomplishment/activity listed on your resume that demonstrates community involvement and is most meaningful to you. Describe your participation in detail. **(250 WORDS MAXIMUM / 150 MINIMUM)**
3. **Educational Plans (10 points):** What do you want to study and why? Where do you see yourself in 10 years? **(250 WORDS MAXIMUM / 150 MINIMUM)**
4. **Personal Statement (30 points):** This is the space for you to tell us more about yourself on any topic of your choosing. What does the committee need to know about you that can't be found on your application? Be creative. Have fun with it! **(350 WORDS MAXIMUM / 250 MINIMUM)**

**Letter of Recommendation from a Teacher (10 points):** Please include teacher contact information—a work email address and phone number.

**Overall Application (10 points):** Grammar, spelling, appearance and completeness.

\* Please type all answers. Essays not using the format or answering the questions outlined above will not be considered. Finalists are required to participate in an interview with the selection committee. They can select one of these two dates so please make note of them on your calendar: March 18<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> between 2:30-4:40pm, after which time final selections will be made.
